 - d. Suspension
 - e. Erasure

- 2014 No record of any Trust doctors being investigated by the G.M.C.

- 2016 2 Trust doctors being investigated by the G.M.C. (1 restriction on fitness to practice and 1 no undertakings)
- 2017 3 Trust doctors being investigated by the G.M.C. (no further action taken by GMC)
- 2018 1 Trust doctor investigated by the G.M.C. who are taking no further action
