Hazard	Risks	Control	Risk Rating
Workstation layout and design.	Work related upper limb disorder (WRULD) e.g. aches to neck, shoulder and arms. Repetitive strain injury (RSI) e.g. peritendinitis (inflammation where tendon joins muscle) Carpal Tunnel Syndrome (painful condition where nerves pass through the carpal bone in the hand). Headaches, blurred vision and sore eyes.	The young person should complete a Display Screen Equipment (DSE) assessment as part of their induction program.	Low
Load moving and handling.	Work Related Musculoskeletal Injuries (MSI).	Avoid manual handling operations where possible. Provide suitable equipment to assist in the handling/moving activity. Ensure manual handling instruction and training is given at induction. Undertake suitable and sufficient manual handling risk assessment and review as required.	Medium

<p>Chemical agents and substances including photocopier toner.</p>	<p>Occupational dermatitis; occupational asthma; rhinitis; contact dermatitis and respiratory sensitisers, among others.</p>	<p>Information and training of the young person using the manufacturers COSHH data sheet. Supply personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gloves. Undertake suitable and sufficient COSHH assessment as required.</p>	<p>Low to medium</p>
<p>Work Machinery and Equipment.</p>	<p>Contact with moving parts, contact with electricity if equipment is poorly maintained, cuts and abrasions, tripping hazards, slips and falls.</p>	<p>Equipment should be properly guarded and training and instruction should be given and recorded and Supervision should take place. Ensure PWER is understood and complied with.</p>	<p>Low</p>
<p>Organisation of work activities. Method and procedure of carrying out work tasks.</p>	<p>Injury or ill health could occur if a safe system of work is not implemented and followed and fully understood by the young person.</p>	<p>Improved awareness by comprehensive training instruction and supervision given by a competent person.</p>	<p>Medium</p>
