Information Requested:

I am writing to request the below information under the Freedom of Information Act.

1. How many gay / bisexual / MSM men are on the PrEP Impact trial hosted at Colchester Sexual Health?
2. How many gay / bisexual / MSM men are currently waiting to join your PrEP Impact trial at Colchester Sexual Health, ie, on a waiting list?
3. How many gay / bisexual / MSM men have been prevented from joining the PrEP Impact trial at Colchester Sexual Health due to it being full / paused to MSM?
4. How many gay / bisexual / MSM men have previously been turned away from the PrEP Impact trial at Colchester Sexual Health due to other reasons?

Essex Partnership University NHS Foundation Trust ceased to provide Sexual Health services in South East Essex on 31st March 2019; however, The Trust can confirm that we were not involved in the PrEP Impact Trial at Colchester Sexual Health.
