Whether services are provided by in-house or outsourced providers.

 The annual spend of your Essex Partnership University NHS Foundation Trust region on Secure Mental Health Transport Services.

The annual spend for the most recent financial year 2023/24 was £123k.

 Who your current outsourced providers are and the duration of their current contracts.

Ambulance Transfers Ltd Specialist Medical Transport Ltd EMED Group

Current contracts expire in December 2024 and the trust is currently undertaking a new procurement process for a contract commencing in January 2025

Your forward-looking budget for Secure Mental Health Transport Services
 The annual budget is £230k.

This request is related to Secure Mental Health Transport Services. This is defined as:

- Mental Health Transport: Transport services provided for individuals requiring secure mental health transportation (from high to low secure psychiatric settings), including court escorts, attendance for hearings, transports to and from prisons, police stations, A&E departments and outpatient appointments.
- Section 135 / 136: Transport services provided for individuals being transported from the community to other settings under sections 135 or 136 of the Mental Health Act.
