Information Requested:

1. Please can you provide me with a list of low secure units that accept patients currently detained under the Mental Health Act 1983 (as amended by the 2007 Act) who have a diagnosis of a Personality Disorder and a clinical likely diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder?

The Trust believes that this information is publicly available on the <https://eput.nhs.uk/our-services/?selectedServiceType=Adult+mental+health+services> website, all our low secure units accept patients with the above diagnosis. Therefore is applying a Section 21 exemption of the Act (Information accessible to applicant by other means):

2. It would also be helpful if they could address neurodevelopmental difficulties and deliver the Good Lives Programme (risk programme for patients not necessarily accepting of the sexual offence).

This request is outside the scope of a Freedom of Information request, as it not asking for recorded information that Essex Partnership University Trust holds.

Section 21: Information accessible to applicant by other means.

(1) Information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant otherwise than under section 1 is exempt information.

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1)—

(a) information may be reasonably accessible to the applicant even though it is accessible only on payment, and

(b) information is to be taken to be reasonably accessible to the applicant if it is information which the public authority or any other person is obliged by or under any enactment to communicate (otherwise than by making the information available for inspection) to members of the public on request, whether free of charge or on payment.

(3) For the purposes of subsection (1), information which is held by a public authority and does not fall within subsection (2)(b) is not to be regarded as reasonably accessible to the applicant merely because the information is available from the public authority itself on request, unless the information is made available in accordance with the authority's publication scheme and any payment required is specified in, or determined in accordance with, the scheme.
