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### Information Requested:

1. All written and electronic correspondence between your trust and NHS England, responding to instructions set out in an NHS England letter, dated 30 September 2022, titled 'Quality and Safety of Mental Health, Learning Disability and Autism Inpatient services', including:
  - a. Reviews of safeguarding of care and any immediate issues requiring action now, including, but not limited to freedom to speak up arrangements, advocacy provision, complaints, CETRs and ICETRs, and other feedback on services
  - b. Reviews of restrictive interventions, long-term segregations and plans for reduction
  - c. Reviews of culture  
Feedback to the national team regarding the inpatient quality programme run by Liz Durrant

The letter received from NHS England dated 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022, asked for Trust Boards to review and did not ask for any central return to be made.
