- 2) what parents are required to do before receiving a block of speech therapy sessions (attend a course, etc.) To attend an assessment appointment and agree joint targets with SLT, to commit to attending proposed session(s) and practice work given between each session and to notify the service if an appointment cannot be made. No requirement to attend any courses prior to the offer of indirect/direct input if deemed clinically appropriate by SLT.
- 3) what support you provide for children for whom an AAC device is deemed appropriate

To attend an assessment appointment and agree joint targets with SLT, to commit to attending proposed session(s) and practice work given between each session and to notify the service if an appointment cannot be made. No requirement to attend any courses prior to the offer of indirect/direct input if deemed clinically appropriate by SLT.

 - a. SLT's 13.46 wte for the clinic based service
 - 3.85 wte for ABS delivery so in total across the clinic based and ABS services 17.31 wte (bands 5 8)
