 Approval or intention to obtain one
- Consultant positions, you will also need to be on the Specialist Register and have Approved Clinician Status, or be in the process registering.

Like all trips, mine started with some discontent of where I was and the dream of a better destination. You pack your bags, book the flight and take the trip, hoping for some interesting, enjoyable times ahead. You leave your comfort, familiar zone with 2 bags and a flight ticket, dreading the fragility of the journey ahead, where anything can shatter it, like bad timing, uneducated choices, unexpected circumstances or the false promises of the destination.

My trip to the UK started 5 years ago. My destination there was chosen after a thorough search, one as meticulously done as you would expect from someone who has not stepped in the UK before. A place close to London but with cheaper prices, somewhere with easy accessibility to an international airport, country sides, beaches, somewhere not too crowded but not guite small and with the best schools there is to offer. The search results came up with a city named as best place to live in the UK that year, 2018. The name of the destination was Chelmsford, Essex and if you are a psychiatrist like me, then you call the trust giving you this opportunity EPUT.

I came to EPUT as an MTI doctor, a training program sponsored by the Royal College allowing IMG to train and work in the UK for two years. The initial steps and emails were countless. I laugh now looking back at the questions I bombarded the HR department with; but they never did. They answered my queries and offered guidance to my submissions. They committed to the timeline, and I was in the UK on the exact date that was agreed on almost a year ago.

You step in the UK and you immediately need to re-establish everything you took for granted; accommodation, transportation, utilities, schools... You just signed a contract stating that you start work the following day and you wonder how is this possible? But with the understanding and support I was given from the very first day I started to realise quickly how this could really work out.

Once settled, you face the challenges of accommodating everything you learned into a new system while trying to progress with your career. And once again I was not disappointed, flooded with support and guidance I was able to finish all my MRCPSYCH exams during my first year in the UK.



I just got my dream consultant job few months back.

I applied to a higher training post before the end of my MTI program. And I was lucky enough to get my first choice for matching. If you are still wondering, of course it was in EPUT. I spent my higher training years in the same educational and supportive environment. Providing me with the communication and managerial skills I will use later on when I became a consultant psychiatrist. In 5 years my job titles changed quickly from MTI trainee, to higher trainee, to consultant psychiatrist.

I just got my dream consultant job few months back, one with short commuting time and with very supportive managers and directors. I have no idea where the trip will end, and to be honest I don't care as much, as they say it is the journey not the destination that matters. And mine with EPUT continues to be quite an enjoyable one.




I have been able to realize my dream of becoming an old-age psychiatrist, working in the NHS.
